## **The Part-Time Staff Member Award (4)**

Value: \$750  
Eligibility: Awarded to a Member employed by the Association.  
Criteria: Based on outstanding performance in that individual's area and dedication, over and above the requirements, to the Association.

## **Student Group Award (2)**

Value: \$300  
Eligibility: Awarded to a Student Group  
Criteria: Based on outstanding dedication to the student body through Student Group involvement which goes well above and beyond the predetermined priority of that Student Group.

## **College Member Contribution to Student Affairs Award (2)**

Value: Framed Certificate and \$20 Association Gift Certificate  
Eligibility: Awarded to a member of the Polytechnic community.  
Criteria: Based on a dedication to student affairs. The recipient of this award will have continually been involved in student activities, and/or committees of the Association.

## **The Student Of The Year Award (1)**

Value: \$2000  
Eligibility: Awarded to a student who has been enrolled in a full-time capacity. Executives of the Association in the year considered will not be eligible.  
Criteria: Awarded to the student who most demonstrates outstanding contributions and leadership in the field of student affairs. The recipient of this award will have performed at a level well above the requirements of that individual's position.

## **Terry Wood Scholarship (1)**

Value: \$1000  
Eligibility: Awarded to a Member of the Association.  
Criteria: Student must have demonstrated personal growth and involvement leading to the betterment of the Students' Association and its members.

## **The Outstanding Dedication Award (5)**

Value: \$1000  
Eligibility: Awarded to a Member of the Association. Executives of the Association in the year considered will not be eligible.  
Criteria: Based on outstanding contribution and leadership in the field of student affairs. The recipients of this award will have performed at a level well above and beyond the requirements of the individual's position.

## **Student Volunteer Award (5)**

Value: \$750  
Eligibility: Awarded to a Member of the Association.  
Criteria: Based on volunteer activities that benefit the students of Red Deer Polytechnic.

## **Mental Health Initiatives Award (5)**

Value: \$750  
Eligibility: Awarded to a Member of the Association.  
Criteria: Based on outstanding leadership in the area of mental health initiatives.

### The Roy North Scholarship (1)

- Value: \$750
- Eligibility: Awarded to a student attending a credit program, including Collaborative programs, in the Fall and Winter terms of the current academic year. Students' Association Executive Council members for the current academic year are not eligible.
- Criteria: Awarded to the student who most demonstrates outstanding contributions and leadership in the field of student affairs. The recipient of this award will have performed at a level well above the requirements of that individual's position.

### The Involvement in College Governance Scholarship (2)

- Value: \$750
- Eligibility: Student continuing in the second year of full-time studies at Red Deer Polytechnic.
- Criteria: Involvement in college or student government, academic standing, and financial need considered.

### The Dr. Guillermo Barron Memorial Philosophy Scholarship (1)
